2025 HeartCode ACLS

Purpose and Intended Audience:

HeartCode ACLS is a blended learning course. The online portion (Step 1) is a self-directed, comprehensive eLearning program that uses adaptive learning technology to allow learners to acquire and demonstrate ACLS skills using a personalized learning path that adapts in real time to the learner's performance. The program is designed for healthcare professionals who need ACLS training for their clinical duties. The hands-on portion (Step 2) is completed with an AHA ACLS instructor.

- Step 1 is completed at the American Heart Association website which uses dramatizations, cognitive assessments, • illustrations, knowledge checks, and interactive activities. This program takes approximately 4 hours to complete.
- Step 2 is the hands-on skills practice and testing by a BLS Instructor at UnityPoint Health Des Moines and requires • approximately 2-4 hours to complete.
- Both steps must be completed to receive an ACLS Provider eCard. .

How to Complete Step 1:

Log onto the American Heart Association website at HeartCode® ACLS Online | AHA eLearning for the HeartCode ACLS Online. Purchase and complete all the lessons.

Print out or download the HeartCode certificate showing completion of the Step 1 online portion. Email to DM CTC@unitypoint.org.

How to Complete Step 2:

The certificate showing completion of the online portion must be presented prior to the hands-on skills portion of this class. An ACLS Provider eCard will be issued after the successful completion of the hands-on skills portion of this class.

The cost is \$125 (\$100 for UPH Clinic employees) for the hands-on skills portion of this class.
