UnityPoint Health Renovating College Facility to Accommodate Growing Child Protection Center Expansion

To accommodate increased demand of services provided by the Allen Hospital Child Protection Center (CPC), UnityPoint Health – Waterloo is undertaking a \$1.5 million renovation of Allen College's Alumni Hall. This announcement, as of May 5, coincides with the 15th anniversary of the center.

The CPC, which serves 27 counties in northeast and north central lowa, will move operations from its current location at Allen Hospital to Alumni Hall, which nearly doubles its floorspace from 5,200 square feet to nearly 9,000. The added space allows for growth as the CPC's services continue expanding to include a Family Resiliency Program, child abuse prevention programming and mental health counseling along with continued investigative services.

Among the improvements will be a third forensic interview and observation rooms, larger medical exam rooms, multidisciplinary team space and centralized operations for CPC team members. Also, there will be an improved Family Resiliency Program clubhouse space, which allows the team's nurse practitioner to conduct developmental assessments of children who were exposed to harmful substances prenatally or in their



environment. The assessments include a physical exam, while giving a chance to observe a child's play activity, motor skills and interaction with caregivers.

Alumni Hall, located at 1955 Heath Street, directly across the street from Allen College, is currently utilized by UnityPoint Health as a community childcare center. The childcare center is moving to its new location at North Crossing this summer. Once that transition is complete, renovation of Alumni Hall can begin.

"We're incredibly grateful for this commitment from UnityPoint Health and the Allen Foundation, "says Katie Strub, Senior Clinic Administrator of the CPC and Allen Women's Health. "We embrace the UnityPoint Health mission, which is to improve the health of the people and communities we serve. I believe this project is what it looks like when the entire organization believes in that vision."
