## NEW MANOMETRY FOR SURGERY DEPARTMENT

Thanks to your support, the GRMC Foundation helped the Surgery Department purchase a high-resolution manometry system. This system is used to measure the muscles at the top and bottom of the esophagus, and also measures the pressure, speed, and wave pattern of muscle contractions along the esophagus while swallowing.

"This new equipment has made esophageal manometry easier for our technicians due to shorter procedure times which makes the procedure more tolerable for our patients," says Angie Oakie, RN, BSN, MHA, GRMC Surgery Department Manager.
