# 2025 HeartCode BLS

#### **Purpose and Intended Audience:**

HeartCode BLS is a blended learning course. The online portion (Step 1) is a self-directed, comprehensive eLearning program that uses adaptive learning technology to allow learners to acquire and demonstrate Basic Life Support skills using a personalized learning path that adapts in real time to the learner's performance. The program is designed for healthcare professionals who need BLS training for their clinical duties. The hands-on portion (Step 2) is completed with an AHA BLS instructor.

- Step 1 is completed at the American Heart Association website which uses dramatizations, cognitive assessments, illustrations, knowledge checks, and interactive activities. This program takes approximately 1.5 hours to complete.
- Step 2 is the hands-on skills practice and testing by a BLS Instructor at UnityPoint Health Des Moines and requires approximately 1.5 hours to complete.
- Both steps must be completed to receive a BLS Provider eCard.

#### **How to Complete Step 1:**

Log onto the American Heart Association website at <u>HeartCode® BLS Online</u> | <u>AHA eLearning</u> for the HeartCode BLS Online. Purchase and complete all the lessons.

Print out or download the HeartCode certificate showing completion of the Step 1 online portion. Email to DM CTC@unitypoint.org.

## **How to Complete Step 2:**

Click to register at this link: 2025 BLS HeartCode. The certificate showing completion of the online portion must be presented prior to the hands-on skills portion of this class. A BLS Provider eCard will be issued after the successful completion of the hands-on skills portion of this class.

The cost is \$85.00 for the hands-on skills portion of this class. Make checks payable to UnityPoint Health-CTC or call 515-241-6811 to pay with credit card.

#### **CE Credit:**

Continuing Education Credit is provided by the AHA upon successful completion of the computer portion for physicians, physician assistants, nurses, pharmacists, and EMTs/paramedics.
