

EMERGENCY ROOM RENOVATIONS TO BEGIN!

The St. Luke's Emergency Department (ED) is an integral part of the hospital. It provides the best medical and surgical care to patients arriving in need of immediate attention. Staffed 24/7 with specially trained nurses, nurse practitioners and emergency physicians, the ED offers advanced trauma technology to care for patients with acute illnesses or injuries like cardiac arrest, stroke, critical injuries, pregnancy complications, upper respiratory issues, and symptoms associated with Covid-19.

Due to the significant growth, St. Luke's has an opportunity to improve emergency care. The current ED layout no longer meets the demands of our patients and their families. By remodeling the space, it will improve the coordination of care, boost efficiencies, close the gap on psychiatric emergencies, and distribute resources during high utilization times.

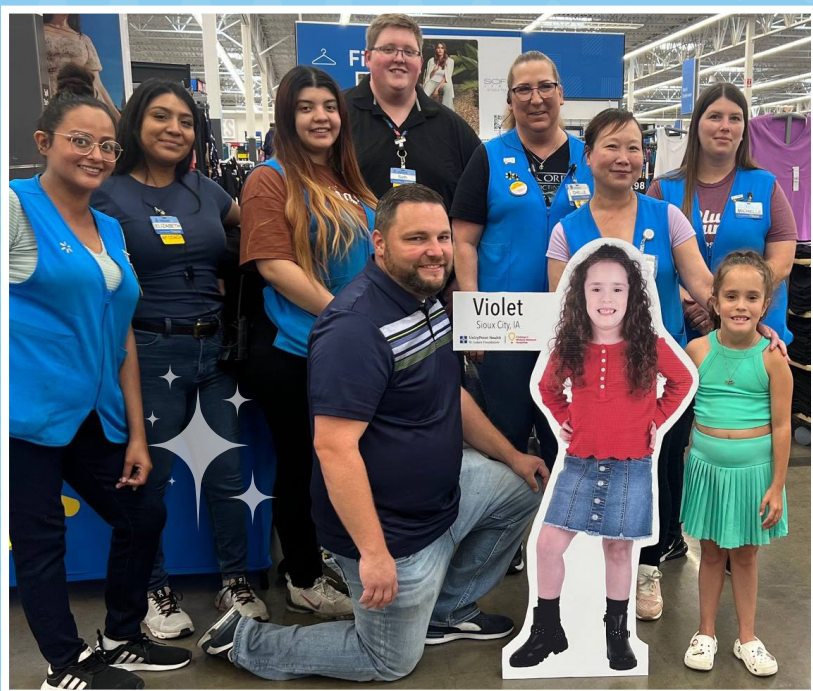
The reimagined ED will include the relocation and expansion of the ED waiting room, two new fast-track triage bays, conversion of four infusion rooms into modern, ligature free



rooms that provide a private and healing environment, and a model to improve patient flow, with the goal of reducing wait times and increasing patient satisfaction. This renovation will include three phases. The project began on July 22 and is expected to be completed before the end of the year.
