Fire Safety House Severe Weather Education - Terms and Conditions

Please be advised of the following terms and conditions for using the Blank Children's Hospital Fire Safety House for Severe Weather Education.

- 1. Please remember that your reservation form is a request, and all use depends upon the availability of the Fire Safety House and its staff.
- 2. Fire Safety House staff will bring the House to your location, set it up for your education requested and train your volunteers.
- 3. The Fire Safety House is an educational tool and must be adequately staffed. We recommend a minimum of 3-5 volunteers per 4-hour shift for Severe Weather Training. It is the responsibility of the hosting fire department or community group to provide volunteers.
- 4. Please allow adequate room for the Fire Safety House trailer (38 ft. long; 8 ft. wide; 12 ft. high) plus the tow vehicle.
- 5. If providing Severe Weather Training to young children (Pre-K) we suggest parent involvement when going through the simulator.
- 6. The Fire Safety House runs on its own generator. We will let you know if you need to provide a 110-volt electrical hookup with 30-amp service.
- 7. Every child under age 18 must have a signed consent form prior to touring the Fire Safety House for Severe Weather Training or Fire Safety Education.
- 8. Please allow 15-20 minutes for each group of 8-10 children.
- 9. The hosting fire department and/or community organization is responsible for any damage to the Fire Safety House incurred during its visit to your location.
