- Stoddard Cancer Center became the first center in the state to offer Gamma Tile, an exciting new option for the treatment of brain tumors that targets tumor cells where recurrence is most likely while preserving healthy brain tissue.
- The Stoddard Cancer Center's Radiation Oncology Department was named a radiopharmaceutical therapy center of excellence and Xofigo was added to the menu of available treatments for advanced cancers which included Pluvicto and Lutathera.
- Stoddard Cancer Center's reach is benefiting lowans statewide - serving 62 of lowa's 99 counties.
- Helped reduce barriers to cancer screening through providing cancer prevention education at more than 25 community events.

The Edge system represents an evolution in how radiosurgery can treat a wider array of cancers and clinical cases, opening the door to more treatment options.

As we continue to see an increase in the number of patients treated at Stoddard Cancer Center, our facilities will need to grow to keep pace with demand. Thanks to you, John Stoddard Cancer Center continues to meet the unique health care needs of cancer patients throughout Des Moines and Iowa. **Donors helped with the following:**

- Expanded the What's On Your Mind free counseling program. Counselors are now available 40 hours a week for patients and their families, free of charge - allowing them immediate access to mental health services.
- Expanded the EMPOWER Boutique and Salon to offer manicures in addition to haircuts, while introducing several new products. This impactful service allows patients to look their best, so they feel their best.
- Expanded navigator support with the addition of a social worker and financial navigator. This team helped more than 400 patients last year with things like Medicaid re-enrollment, ensuring no lapse in coverage and patients are able to continue with their cancer treatment.
- Updated inpatient rooms. These updates help provide a more comfortable experience for our patients and their quests.
- Provided professional development for more than 50 team members. This education ensures team members receive specialized oncology training to enhance patient care.

• Record growth for the Charlie Cutler Healing & Wellness Program. This transformational program offers integrative oncology services through massage therapy, music therapy, art therapy, acupuncture, aromatherapy, free nutritious meals as well as nutrition classes, a writing circle, Mindfulness Based Stress Reduction resources and so much more.
