- 1. **Study Personnel Changes** Submit a *Study Personnel Changes* form if study personnel <u>at Meriter</u> are changing. The IRB sees if study personnel meet institutional requirements for conducting research at Meriter which may include health and safety checks and other qualifications.
- 2. Amendments for Ceded Research Submit an amendment if:
 - a. you are changing how Private Health Information (PHI) is solicited, stored and protected, or the timeline for destroying identifiers is altered.
 - b. There are changes to the protocol or study documents affected by state law or intuitional policy (e.g., HIV testing, new HIPAA authorization document).
 - c. There is a new study protocol or new consent document. Examples New study population or sub-study is added requiring a new consent/new protocol.
- 3. **Amendments for Exempt Research -** Submit an amendment if:
 - a. the changes may impact the Exempt status of your study.
 - b. you are changing how Private Health Information (PHI) is solicited, stored and protected, or the timeline for destroying identifiers is altered.
- 4. **Amendments when Meriter is Not Engaged** Submit an amendment if:
 - a. Meriter's involvement in your research is changing
 - b. you are changing how Private Health Information (PHI) is solicited, stored and protected, or the timeline for destroying identifiers is altered.
- 5. **Reportable Events for Ceded Research Submit a report:**
 - a. When the reviewing IRB requires an event be reported to Meriter IRB.
 - b. When an event occurs of such severity or significance (e.g., serious and/or continuing noncompliance, an anticipated event that poses substantial risks to subjects or others) that the Meriter IRB will be assisting the reviewing IRB in addressing the event.
