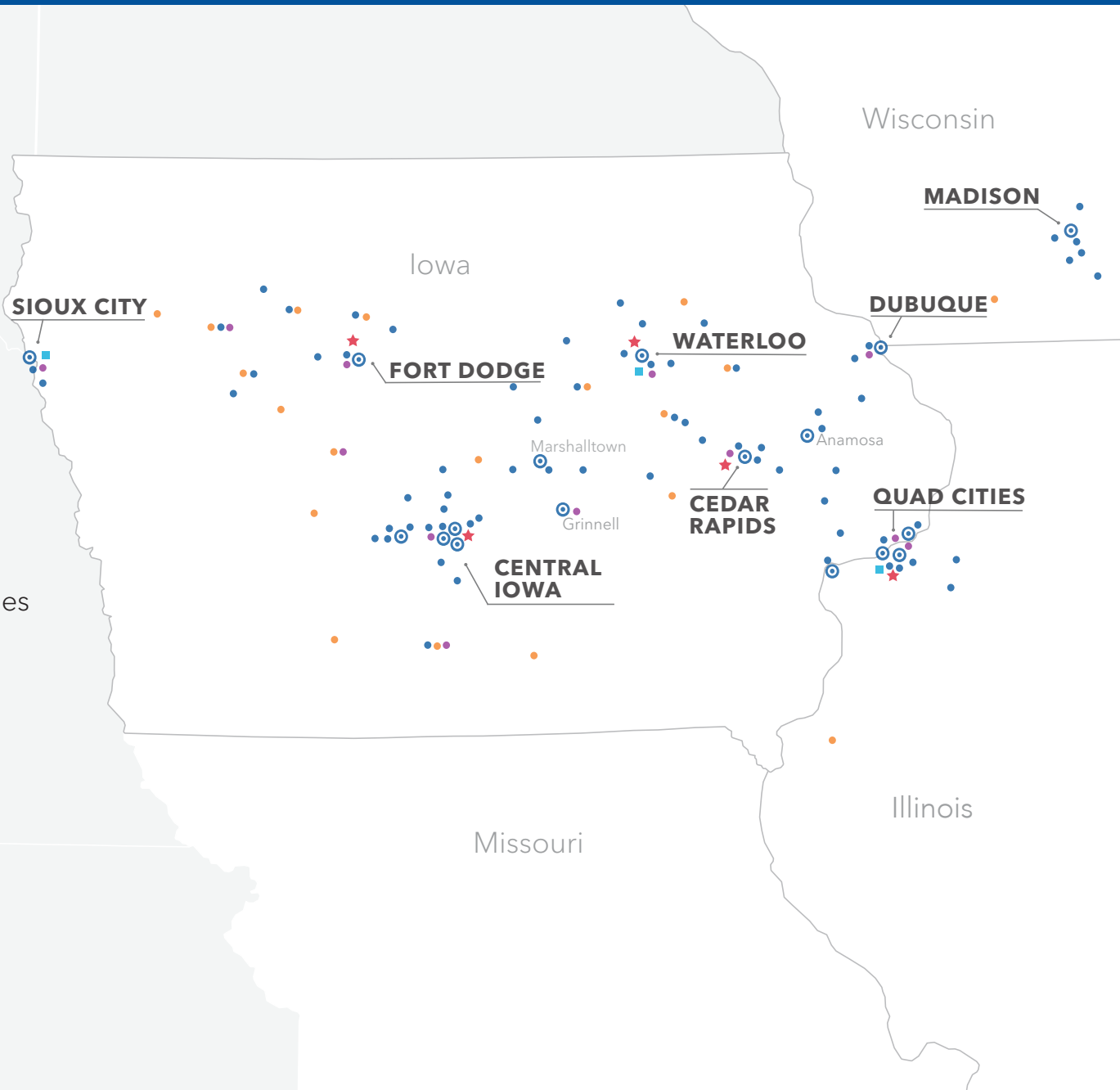


UnityPoint Health System Map
