Behavioral Health Geriatric Unit	Our Older Adult Unit provides specialized care for geriatric patients, many of whom have dementia and exhibit behavioral challenges, often transferring from other facilities for advanced behavioral management. The unit also serves as overflow for the Adult Unit, accommodating a diverse range of patients aged 18 to 100. Strong teamwork is essential, with staff conducting assessments, managing crises, providing care, and performing mental health evaluations, while maintaining a 1:4-5 staff-to-patient ratio for personalized care.	4 hour block, 1/day
Behavioral Health Adolscent Unit	We are a 17-bed unit that serves patients aged 5 to 18 and their families, addressing issues such as anxiety, depression, suicidal ideation, anger management, adjustment disorders, and substance abuse. Our care team includes psychiatrists, family therapists, nurses, recreation therapists, and social workers, with additional support from occupational therapy, dietary, and spiritual care to provide comprehensive services tailored to each patient's needs.	4 hour block, 1/day
Behavioral Health Adult Unit	We are a 24-bed unit serving patients 18 and older with mental health and substance abuse diagnoses. Integrated Health Home (IHH)	BA/BS level students observe our multi-disciplinary team make referrals, provide case management/care coordination and health promotion services	4 hour block, 1/day
Program for Assertive Community Treatment (PACT)	Shadow a multidisciplinary team of professionals providing a variety of services to individuals who experience psychosis. Staff include case managers, peer support specialist, substance abuse specialist, vocational specialist, therapist, nurses, and prescribers. Services are provided in client homes or community locations.	4 hour block, 1/day
Abbe Mental Health Crisis Services	Shadow crisis intervention specialist (CIS) or social worker that is staff 24 hours per day at Mental Health Access Centers of Linn County Mental Health Access Center in Cedar Rapids and GuideLink in Iowa City. Our goal is to work with the individuals who are experiencing a mental well being crisis that is defined by the individual. This encompasses someone who may have a primary mental health diagnosis or may be someone with their first occurrence of mental health needs. We provide skill building on managing symptoms and crisis situations by learning skills as well as understanding the community resources.	4 hour block, 1/day
